

PAOLO NUTINI CHARITY GIG IN PAISLEY ON 6th August 2024 - IN AID OF THE STAR PROJECT & DOCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS (Medicines San Frontier)

Paolo Nutini will play a charity gig in his hometown of **Paisley** at the end of his European Tour to raise vital funds for Paisley-based charity **STAR Project** and to aid medical staff working in Gaza and the West Bank through the charity **Médecins Sans Frontières/Doctors Without Borders**.

The show on **6th August 2024** will be held at **Paisley Town Hall** and **500 lucky winners** will get the chance to **win a pair of tickets each** to attend this exclusive one off show which will be Paolo's only Scottish show of 2024 and his first time playing in Paisley since his show at the Abbey in 2017.

- Texts cost 1 standard rate message.

- The donation of £3 will show on your mobile phone bill as a charge to 70313.
- Entries made after the close date of 23:59pm on Sunday 7th July 2024 will not count and may still be charged.
